ABEYANCE AND PROTECTIVE ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the allegations of said Petition have been sustained in that the child has committed the offense(s) set forth in the Petition and said child is hereby found to be in a state of delinquency/unruliness and in need of treatment, rehabilitation or supervision.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the final disposition of this case will be held in ABEYANCE for a period of 180 days from the date hereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if said child complies with all terms and conditions of this Order as hereinafter stated, the above-referenced Petition will be dismissed. However, if the child fails to comply with the terms and conditions of this Order as hereinafter stated, the child will be returned to this Court for final disposition of the above-referenced Petition.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that during this continuance said child will abide by the following specified conditions:

1. Said child shall not violate federal, state, county, or municipal laws.
2. Said child will report to your Probation Officer and be on time for all visits. Child will follow the oral and written directions given to you by your Probation Officer or any officer of the court.
3. For a period of 30 days after the date of this order, said child will not leave the residence unless you are under the direct supervision of your parents or an activity approved by your Probation Officer.
4. Said child shall abide by a curfew of 8 P.M. on Sunday through Thursday and 9 P.M. on Friday through Saturday.
5. Said child shall attend school each day and shall not be a discipline problem at home or at school. Said child will make passing grades from this day forward.
6. Said child shall not possess or consume any tobacco, drugs or alcohol or be around anyone taking drugs or alcohol and shall be subject to random drug screens upon the request of the Probation Department.
7. Said child shall report any change of address, telephone, or school to the Juvenile Probation Officer.
8. Said child shall perform _____ hours of community service at the direction of the Probation Department and shall comply with all rules of the program.
9. Said child shall take all medications as prescribed.
10. Said child shall not have in your possession any weapon. Weapon being defined as any object, device or instrument which, when used against a person, is likely to result in bodily injury, as defined in OCGA 16-11-127.1(a)(2).
11. Said child shall be subject to search and seizure of his/her personal property at home, school or other locations.
12. Said child shall not join, participate in or associate with gangs or gang members. You shall not possess any gang related materials, symbols, or paraphernalia.
13. Said child shall attend the following Counseling Program(s): as directed
14. Said child will successfully complete the short-term program if assigned.

Other Conditions:

Complete a Research paper on The effects of Weapons on School Property, and how Weapons on School Property has effected the Schools and Community over the past ten years.

14. Said child shall attend the following Outreach Program(s):
- Tutorial Program** – Cost \$100.00 (6 weeks) Tutorial education. Youth only.
 - Family Concepts** – Cost \$150.00 (8 weeks) Vital keys for successful parent/youth relationships. Youth and parent are required to attend.
 - Y-JOP (G) – No Cost** – (8 weeks) Girls gender Program. Youth & parent required to attend.
 - Y-FAM Program** - \$200.00 (4 weeks) Provided through YMCA . . . Family enrichment program.
 - Truancy Education** – Cost \$100.00 (2 hour) Education Seminar on truancy related issues. Youth and parent are required to attend.
 - Y.E.S. Program** – Cost \$100.00 (6 weeks) Home study with 6 hour classroom component. Youth only.
 - S.U.P.E.R. Program** – Cost \$100.00 (2 weeks) Drug/Alcohol Awareness. Youth and parent required.

PROTECTIVE ORDER

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the word "parent(s)" as herein used shall mean and include the child's natural parent(s), step parent(s), adoptive parent(s) legal custodians, foster care parent(s), guardians, or any other person with whom the child has been placed and who exercises parental guidance, supervision and control over said child.

The Court having found that it is in the interest of said child that a Protective Order be entered requiring that the Parent(s) perform certain acts; whereupon,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that during this continuance said child's parent(s)/ guardian(s):


Joy Rankin shall abide by the following specified conditions:

1. Report any violation of the terms and conditions of this Order child's Juvenile Probation Officer within twenty-four(24) hours of having knowledge of said violation.
2. Adequately define and explain the rules and regulations of the home to said child.
3. Insure that the child is awakened, fed, and made ready to attend school on time each day, including summer school if required.
4. Insure that the child attends school unless lawfully excused.
5. Meet with the child's teachers and counselors at least once per month to determine the performance of the child at school.
6. Meet with the child's Juvenile Probation Officer as required by said personnel and cooperate with said personnel.
7. Provide transportation for the child to all Court ordered programs and to such other places as may be directed by the Juvenile Probation Office, Community Service Coordinator, or the Court.
8. Attend and complete all counseling services recommend by the child's probation order.
9. Shall pay for all juvenile programs, drug screens, testing, counseling services, and medical services that are required for said child. Said funds shall be paid within thirty (30) days after the date that said bill (s) are incurred.
10. _____ Enroll the child in summer school and pay all fees incurred for said enrollment. (If checked)
11. Shall pay to the Juvenile Court:
Initial Supervision Fee of \$ 150 within 90 days
Monthly Supervision Fee of \$ _____ within _____ days
Attorney Fee of \$ _____ within _____ days

ANY WILLFUL VIOLATION OF THE TERMS OF THIS ORDER FOR ABEYANCE AND PROTECTIVE ORDER MAY BE PUNISHABLE BY THE COURT'S CONTEMPT POWERS WHICH INCLUDE THE IMPOSITION OF A FINE AND/OR INCARCERATION.


